King County Candidate Filings For August 21, 2007 Primary

King County Assessor Scott Noble filed for re-election last week and drew an opponent with a similar name. Don't be fooled—VOTE FOR **SCOTT NOBLE**—Incumbent, endorsed candidate, KCDCC member, and Democrat Party activist.

The column to the right details our two, fine candidates for King County Prosecutor.

The King County Council Democratic Incumbents filed for re-election. **Larry Gossett** and **Larry Phillips** drew no opposition, but **Dow Constantine** will have two opponents. A perennial candidate filed as a Democrat in Council District 6 — HE IS NO DEMOCRAT! **Cast your ballots for our endorsed candidates, Larry Gossett, Larry Phillips, and Dow Constantine.**

The Seattle Port Commission races got very interesting with six candidates filing for Position 2 and four candidates filing for Position 5. We have yet to endorse in Position 2 where party activists, Gael Tarleton and Jack Block, Jr., have filed. Position 5 Incumbent **Alec Fisk** has been endorsed by the KCDCC and an upcoming Eastside fundraiser for Alec is detailed on page 3.

Seattle City Council races also became very full although endorsed candidate and incumbent in Position 5, **Tom Rasmussen**, drew no opposition. In Council Position 9, incumbent and endorsed candidate, **Sally Clark**, drew three in opposition.
