I am honored to be endorsed by the King County Democrats. Many Democrats know me from my life-long track record of working for working people. I founded the Economic Opportunity Institute (EOI) to help us maintain our middle class quality of life. At EOI, I developed the policy for the minimum wage initiative, the first in the country to include an automatic annual COLA. I worked successfully to put the early childhood education wage ladder into state law. I was instrumental in passing paid family leave. And I wrote the Basic Health Plan Initiative in 2001.

Still, we have a lot of unfinished business with health coverage. The first thing to do is to expand the Basic Health Plan, enabling all workers who don't have coverage to gain health care. The second thing is to open up Basic Health Plan coverage to all workers and their families who have lost their jobs and can't afford to pay exorbitant fees for individual coverage. In the next two years we must move to health coverage for everyone. We can do this in our state. Already, Senator Karen Keiser has legislation that will achieve universal coverage, enable us to choose between private and public plans, and limit insurance company profits off of ill people. It will also enable us to negotiate down pharmaceutical costs.

I support health care for everyone. This should be a basic right of being an American.

I refuse campaign contributions from Eli Lilly Pharmaceuticals, Premera Insurance, and all other corporations. They have helped us get in the mess we are in, and they stand in the way of health care for everyone.

I depend on the good will, votes, and support of grassroots Democrats and community activists in my campaign for public service. Thank you, King County Democrats, for endorsing my campaign. As the Democrats' Democrat, I will work to put our Democratic values and policies into law. We have work to do!

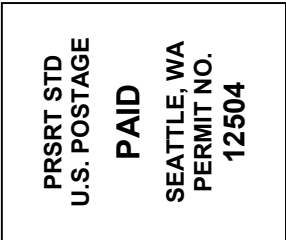
