Thank you for your great support and friendship over the last six years; it has been a pleasure and honor to serve as your KCDCC Chair. The position has afforded the opportunity of meeting many wonderful Democrats and new friends.

Re-organization was December 4, 2004; we had a luncheon and then stayed up for two days and nights ensuring that we had 120 names to present the following Monday at King County Elections for the Governor's recount activity. After the recount, we supported the Party attorneys in the battle in Wenatchee and Governor Gregoire won by 133 votes!

And, that was all in the first part of 2005!

So many events, meetings and so many changes: King County government moving to non-partisan positions, the move to all-mail balloting, the top-two primary, to name a few; we made it through some challenging times. We held conventions, picnics, participated in fairs, festivals, parades, presented precinct maps and history, better communications, judicial forums, and more.

We will have many more victories to celebrate together like the King County Executive race - what a moment for the Democratic Party - thank you, Dow, for being a great candidate and an even better executive.
